Khunjerab Pass



Hunza is a mountainous valley in the Gilgit-Baltistan province of Pakistan. Hunza is situated in the extreme north part of Pakistan, bordering the Wakhan Corridor of Afghanistan and the Xinjiang region of China.

Passu is a small village in the Gilgit-Baltistan province of Pakistan. It is a popular tourist destination because of its beautiful sweeping landscapes, and vistas of the 7,478 m (24,534 ft) tall Passu Sar mountain, the Passu Glacier, and Passu Cones.

A high mountain pass in the Karakoram range, Khunjerab is the highest paved international border crossing in the world at an elevation of 4,693m.

This beautiful valley offers breath-taking views of some of the most exquisite mountain peaks in the world.

Passu lies between two glaciers, Passu and Batura Glaciers. The latter is the seventh longest non-polar glacier in the world measuring 56km in length.

Khunjerab is also the official border crossing between Pakistan and China and is a popular tourist destination among the Pakistanis and Chinese.

Rakasposhi viewing point, Altit Fort, Hobar Glacier are the places to visit here. The valley is also home to Attabad lake which was formed after a 2010 landslide and is now a popular tourist spot, it has a natural teal-blue color with high mountaneous backdrop that gives it a picturesque view.

Places to visit here are Passu Cones, Batura Lake, Passu Village, and Passu Glacier.

The long, relatively flat pass is often snow-covered during winters and is closed for heavy traffic from November 30 - May 1.



Kaghan



Kaghan is a valley located in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is a popular tourist destination with majestic mountains surrounding the entire valley.

Kaghan is home to some of the most breath-taking lakes in the country, namely Saif-ul-Muluk lake, Lulusar Lake, and Dudi-patsar lake. Among the three, Saif-ul-Muluk offers the most stunning views with snow-capped mountains acting as a backdrop to the fresh water lake.

Tourists enjoy breathtaking vistas as well as the excellent food of restaurants setup on the river.

Islamabad



The capital city of Pakistan, Islamabad lies at the foot of the Margalla Hills. This picturesque city is home to 20 universities, and one of the most beautiful and largest mosques in the world.

Popular tourist attractions in and around Islamabad are Faisal Mosque, Margalla Hills, Pakistan Monument, Pir Sowaha, Daman-e-Koh, Shakarparian, Lake View Park, and Saidpur Village.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Islamabad

Meet and greet at airport and hotel transfer.

Day 2: Enroute to Hunza Valley

Departure for Bata Kundi (Kaghan Valley). Stopover at the historic city of Balakot for lunch. Arrival in Bata Kundi (Kaghan valley) around 4pm. After checking-in, group members will be free to explore the city in the afternoon/evening. Overnight stay in Bata Kundi.

Day 3: Enroute to Hunza Valley via Karakoram Highway (KKH)

We will travel through the scenic Babusar pass stopping over in Chilas for lunch, arriving in the evening at Passu (Hunza Valley). Overnight stay in Passu.

Day 4: Day trip to Karimabad

Karimabad city tour and sight seeing. Giving you majestic views with serene environment of some of the highest peaks of the world. Overnight stay at Passu.

Day 5: Day trip to Khunjerab Pass

Visit to the Highest border crossing in the world at 4,693m located at Sust village. Overnight stay in Passu.

Day 6: Rest day

Explore the nearby passu glaciers, cones, etc.

Day 7: Enroute to Kaghan Valley

Departure for Bata Kundi (Kaghan Valley). Lunch at Chilas. Overnight stay at Bata Kundi.

Day 8: Explore Bata Kundi

Day trip to Babusar Top and Lulusar Lake.

Day 9: Trip to Saif-ul-Muluk

Exploring Naran valley and Saif-ul-Muluk lake (Journey by 4x4).

Day 10: Enroute to Islamabad

Lunch at Abbottabad, arriving in Islamabad in the evening.
